COMPLAINT

There is no other pending or resolved civil action arising out of the transaction or occurrence alleged in the Complaint.

NOW COMES PLAINTIFF, CAPITAL ONE, N.A., by its attorneys, Weltman, Weinberg & Reis Co., L.P.A. who for its Complaint state as follows:

1. Plaintiff is doing business in WASHTENAW County, Michigan.
2. Defendant ALYSHIA M DYER, is resident of ANN ARBOR, Michigan.
3. The cause of action that forms the basis of this complaint occurred in WASHTENAW County, Michigan.
4. Venue and jurisdiction are proper in the 14A-4 JUDICIAL DISTRICT COURT.

5. The Defendant opened a revolving credit card account (the "Account") issued by the Plaintiff, currently identified by account number XXXXXXXXXXXXX7494.
6. Through his or her use of the subject credit card, Defendant agreed to pay the Plaintiff for all transactions, interest, charges, and fees assessed on the Account.
7. Plaintiff provided monthly account statements to the Defendant reflecting, among other information, transactions to the Account since the preceding billing period, the total amount due on the Account, and the minimum monthly payment due, see Exhibit A.
8. Despite demand by Plaintiff, Defendant has failed to pay the amount due and owing to Plaintiff on the Account.
9. Pursuant to the terms of the credit card agreement, there is now due and owing to Plaintiff the principal sum of \$20,958.98.
10. Plaintiff does not seek an award of attorney fees, contractual or statutory interest after the date of charge off including any post judgment interest, and expressly disclaims any right it may have to the same.

**WHEREFORE**, Plaintiff respectfully requests that this Honorable Court enter a Judgment in favor of Plaintiff CAPITAL ONE, N.A. and against Defendant ALYSHIA M DYER in the amount of \$20,958.98 plus costs.
